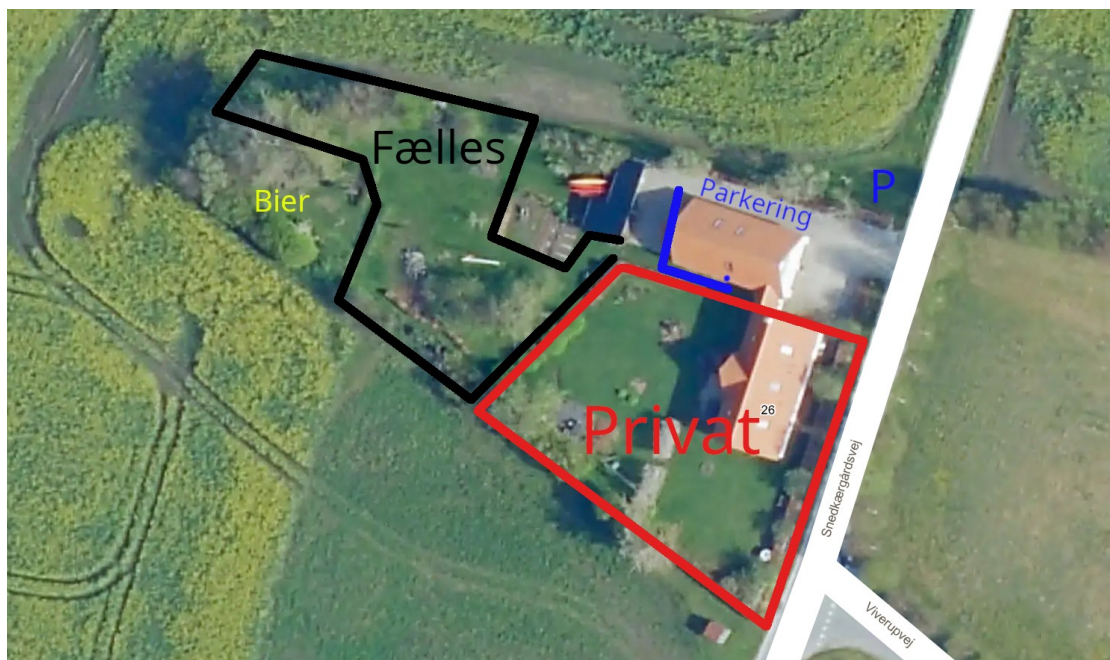


The holiday apartment @ Lykkesmedjen

Welcome to our holiday apartment. This description contains information to help ensure you have a pleasant stay. If you have any questions, please feel free to ask.

Bier = bees

Parking

Parking is available at the locations marked with a "P" on the map. You can park either at the side of the building or at the designated "P" spot, though the latter is on grass.

Our private cars are parked in the garages, and we need to be able to get them out.



Arrival - Entrance

Upon arrival, you can either check if we are home or let yourselves in directly using the code provided.

The entrance to the apartment is at the back. Walk around the right side of the house. You can see a blue line on the map indicating the path to the entrance.



Combination lock (Yale)

There is a keypad lock on the door. You have received a message with the code for your stay.

Unlock

Enter the code and press the (Yale) icon at the bottom. After 10 seconds, the door unlocks.



Lock from the inside

Lift the handle Turn the thumbturn The door is now locked



Unlock from the inside

Turn the thumbturn The door is now unlocked

Lock from the outside

Lift the handle Press the (Yale) icon at the bottom Wait 10 seconds The door is then locked.



Departure

Please tidy up the apartment before departure. If there are dirty dishes, feel free to run the dishwasher.

TV

There is a TV in the apartment. You can watch DR (Danish TV) via the app. If you wish to watch other content, we recommend logging into your own streaming services or connecting a PC via an HDMI cable.

Wi-Fi / Internet

Wireless internet is available. The password can be found in a frame inside the apartment.

Garden

You are welcome to use the communal garden, which is equipped with tables and chairs.

The common garden is marked on the site map.

We have marked the private section of the garden on the map; this area is not for guest use.

Please note that there are bees at the back of the garden. The bees are friendly as long as they are not disturbed.

Playing music in the garden is not permitted.

Kitchen

The kitchen is equipped with tableware and other essentials. Coffee can be made using a French press. There are two induction hobs, a refrigerator with a small freezer compartment, and a dishwasher.

There is an air fryer—large enough to fit even the smallest pizza from SuperBrugsen.

Waste

There are waste bins in the apartment: one for food waste, one for general waste, and one for other recyclables (e.g., plastic, glass, and metal).

If you have more waste than the bins can hold, please place it in the waste containers by the road.

Food waste (Madaffald)

Food waste includes, for example, scraps of fruit, meat, and bread. It must be disposed of in the green bags. Remember to tie a knot.



Residual waste (restaffald)

Residual waste is waste that does not fit into other categories. Pizza boxes are also residual waste.



Plastic, food and beverage cartons

Plastic includes both soft and hard plastic. It must be placed in the same compartment as beverage cartons or food cartons.



Paper and small cardboard items (Papir og småt pap)

This includes newspapers, envelopes, and egg cartons.



Glass

Glass includes, for example, wine bottles, preserve jars, etc.



Metal

Metal includes cans, aluminum trays, etc.

There are waste bins under the sink in the apartment for food waste and general waste, as well as an extra one for cardboard, plastic, metal, and glass—before these are sorted at the large communal bins.

Shopping

You can buy groceries in Dalby, which has both a well-stocked SuperBrugsen and a Netto. It is 2.3 kilometers from Lykkesmedjen.

Bus and train connections

The nearest bus stop is at Druestrup Friskole, approximately 900 meters away. Check departure times at rejseplanen.dk. In the evening, you need to go to Dalby to catch a bus.

If you wish to visit Copenhagen, we recommend driving to Tureby Station or Køge Nord Station; both offer free parking. Check departure times at rejseplanen.dk.

Attractions

Lykkesmedjen can serve as a base for visiting a number of attractions (distances in parentheses):

Gisselfeld Manor (11 km)

Visit both the manor house and the gardens. Events are also held throughout the year.

Bregentved Estate (7 km)

Visit the estate park, which is open a few days a week. The estate has been owned by the Moltke family since King Frederick V gifted it to Adam Moltke.

Camp Adventure – The Forest Tower (12 km)

The Forest Tower is 45 meters tall, and the walk to it is an experience in itself. There is also a climbing park.

Mjødgård (4 km)

A local brewery producing mead. They host events featuring dining, tastings, and music.

Stevns Klint (28 km)

A 17-km-long cliff rising up to 41 meters, listed as a UNESCO World Heritage site. Also visit the Old Church at Højerup (Højerup Gamle Kirke) for a beautiful view.

Cold War Museum Stevnnsfort (30 km)

An underground museum dedicated to Denmark's defense during the Cold War. Excellent guided tours.

Faxe Limestone Quarry (7 km)

Denmark's largest man-made hole in the ground. Free access or fossil hunting via Geomuseum Faxe. Sunglasses recommended on sunny days.

Copenhagen (69 km)

Consider taking the train from Tureby Station (10 km). Many attractions and good train connections running 1–2 times per hour.

Svenskerkløften and Paradishaven (16 km)

A beautiful walk in Hesede Forest featuring rare trees and a historic meltwater gorge.

BonBon-Land (21 km)

Amusement park for children and the young at heart.

Holmegaard Værk (22 km)

Former glassworks – now a museum featuring exhibitions and live glassblowing demonstrations.

Faxe Ladeplads (15 km)

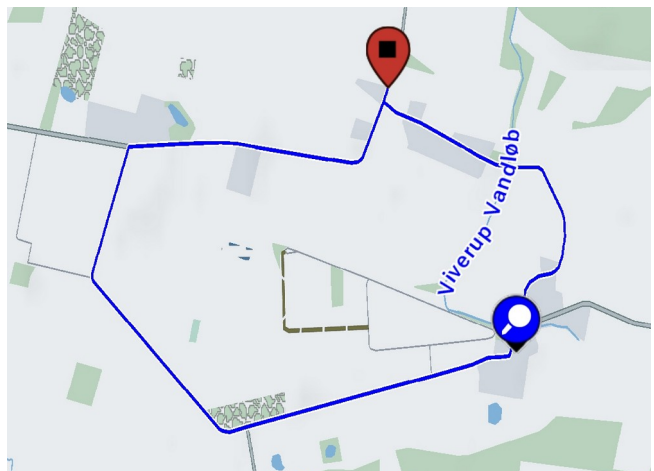
Nice sandy beach.

Hiking trails near Lykkesmedjen

The inland route – 3.6 km.

A flat route. Lykkesmedjen is marked in red. The route is a loop through Viverup and Ås. It is the route we very often take ourselves.



The forest – 3.6 km.

A walk through a small nearby forest. However, you do have to walk along the busy Karisevej for part of the way. It is easiest to head past Druestrup Friskole first (heading north from Lykkesmedjen), as there is a short section at the end of the forest that is easiest to find when approaching from that direction.
